- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 814.103, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the standard
- 10 service retirement annuity for service credited in the elected
- 11 class of membership for a person described by Section 812.002(a)(3)
- 12 is an amount equal to the number of years of service credit in that
- 13 class, times two percent of the state salary, excluding longevity
- 14 pay payable under Section 659.0445 and as adjusted from time to
- 15 time, being paid a district judge.
- (c) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the standard
- 17 service retirement annuity for service credited in the elected
- class of membership for a person described by Section 812.002(a)(1)
- 19 or (2) is an amount equal to the number of years of service credit in
- 20 that class, times two percent of the state salary being paid a
- 21 district judge on August 31, 2019, excluding longevity pay payable
- 22 under Section 659.0445.
- 23 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to the standard service retirement annuity for a person who retires

- 1 on or after September 1, 2019. A person who retires before the
- 2 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect
- 3 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former
- 4 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
