A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the creation of the University of Houston College of
3	Medicine at the University of Houston.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 111, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter K to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER K. UNIVERSITY OF HOUSTON COLLEGE OF MEDICINE
8	Sec. 111.151. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "Board" means the board of regents of the

- 10 University of Houston System.
- 11 (2) "College" means the University of Houston College
 12 of Medicine established under this subchapter.
- Sec. 111.152. THE UNIVERSITY OF HOUSTON COLLEGE OF

 MEDICINE. The University of Houston College of Medicine is a

 college of the University of Houston and is under the management and

 control of the board with degrees offered under the name and
- 17 <u>authority of the University of Houston.</u>
- Sec. 111.153. COURSES AND DEGREES. The board may prescribe

 courses leading to customary degrees and may adopt rules for the
- 20 operation, control, and management of the college as necessary for
- 21 conducting a college of medicine of the first class.
- 22 <u>Sec. 111.154. AFFILIATION AGREEMENTS. The dean of the</u>
- 23 college, on behalf of the board, may execute and carry out an
- 24 affiliation or coordinating agreement with any other entity or

- 1 <u>institution in the college's region.</u>
- 2 Sec. 111.155. GIFTS AND GRANTS. The board may solicit,
- 3 accept, and administer gifts and grants from any public or private
- 4 source for the use and benefit of the college.
- 5 Sec. 111.156. OTHER FACILITIES. In addition to the
- 6 college's facilities, the board may enter into agreements under
- 7 which additional facilities used in the college's teaching and
- 8 research programs, including libraries, auditoriums, research
- 9 facilities, and medical education buildings, may be provided by a
- 10 public or private entity.
- 11 Sec. 111.157. TEACHING HOSPITAL. A teaching hospital
- 12 considered suitable by the board may be provided by a public or
- 13 private entity. The hospital may not be constructed, maintained, or
- 14 operated with state funds.
- SECTION 2. Sections 59.01(1) and (3), Education Code, are
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (1) "Medical staff or students" means medical doctors,
- 18 doctors of osteopathy, dentists, veterinarians, and podiatrists
- 19 appointed to the faculty or professional medical staff employed for
- 20 student health services by The University of Texas System, The
- 21 Texas A&M University System, the Texas Tech University System, $\underline{\text{the}}$
- 22 <u>University of Houston College of Medicine</u>, or the University of
- 23 North Texas Health Science Center at Fort Worth, either full time or
- 24 who, although appointed less than full time (including volunteers),
- 25 either devote their total professional service to such appointment
- 26 or provide services to patients by assignment from the department
- 27 chairman; and interns, residents, fellows, and medical or dental

- 1 students, veterinary students, and students of osteopathy
- 2 participating in a patient-care program in The University of Texas
- 3 System, The Texas A&M University System, the Texas Tech University
- 4 System, the University of Houston College of Medicine, or the
- 5 University of North Texas Health Science Center at Fort Worth.
- 6 (3) "Board" means the board of regents of The
- 7 University of Texas System, the board of regents of The Texas A&M
- 8 University System, the board of regents of the Texas Tech
- 9 University System, the board of regents of the University of
- 10 Houston System, or the board of regents of the University of North
- 11 Texas.
- SECTION 3. Sections 59.02(a) and (c), Education Code, are
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (a) Each board may establish a separate self-insurance fund
- 15 to pay any damages adjudged in a court of competent jurisdiction or
- 16 a settlement of any medical malpractice claim against a member of
- 17 the medical staff or students arising from the exercise of the
- 18 member's [his] appointment, duties, or training with The University
- 19 of Texas System, The Texas A&M University System, the Texas Tech
- 20 University System, the University of Houston College of Medicine,
- 21 or the University of North Texas Health Science Center at Fort
- 22 Worth.
- (c) On the establishment of each fund, transfers to the fund
- 24 shall be made in an amount and at such intervals as determined by
- 25 the board. Each board may receive and accept any gifts or
- 26 donations specified for the purposes of this subchapter and deposit
- 27 those gifts or donations into the fund. Each board may invest

- 1 money deposited in the fund, and any income received shall be
- 2 retained in the fund. The money shall be deposited in any of the
- 3 approved depository banks of The University of Texas System, The
- 4 Texas A&M University System, the Texas Tech University System, the
- 5 University of Houston System, or the University of North Texas
- 6 Health Science Center at Fort Worth. All expenditures from the
- 7 funds shall be paid pursuant to approval by the boards.
- 8 SECTION 4. Section 59.06, Education Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 59.06. LIMITATION ON APPROPRIATED FUNDS. Funds
- 11 appropriated by the legislature to either system, to the Texas Tech
- 12 University Health Sciences Center, to the Texas Tech University
- 13 Health Sciences Center at El Paso, to the University of Houston for
- 14 the University of Houston College of Medicine, or to the University
- 15 of North Texas Health Science Center at Fort Worth from the General
- 16 Revenue Fund may not be used to establish or maintain the fund, to
- 17 purchase insurance, or to employ private legal counsel.
- SECTION 5. Section 61.003(5), Education Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (5) "Medical and dental unit" means The Texas A&M
- 21 University System Health Science Center and its component
- 22 institutions, agencies, and programs; the Texas Tech University
- 23 Health Sciences Center; the Texas Tech University Health Sciences
- 24 Center at El Paso; the University of Houston College of Medicine;
- 25 The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston; The University
- 26 of Texas Southwestern Medical Center; The University of Texas
- 27 Medical School at San Antonio; The University of Texas Dental

- 1 Branch at Houston; The University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer Center; The University of Texas Graduate School of Biomedical 2 Sciences at Houston; The University of Texas Dental School at San Antonio; The University of Texas Medical School at Houston; The 4 5 University of Texas Health Science Center--South Texas and its component institutions, if established under Subchapter N, Chapter 6 74; the nursing institutions of The Texas A&M University System and 7 8 The University of Texas System; and The University of Texas School of Public Health at Houston; and such other medical or dental 9
- SECTION 6. Section 61.501(1), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

- 4 (c) The amount available for distribution from the fund may

- 7 health-related institutions of higher education:
- 8 (1) The University of Texas Health Science Center at
- 9 San Antonio;
- 10 (2) The University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer
- 11 Center;
- 12 (3) The University of Texas Southwestern Medical
- 13 Center;
- 14 (4) The University of Texas Medical Branch at
- 15 Galveston;

- 6 Coordinating Board is in effect under Section 61.092.
- 7 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
