## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the period of continuous eligibility for the medical 3 assistance program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 32.0261, Human Resources Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

Sec. 32.0261. CONTINUOUS ELIGIBILITY. 7 The executive commissioner shall adopt rules in accordance with 42 U.S.C. Section 8 9 1396a(e)(12), as amended, to provide for a period of continuous eligibility for a child under 19 years of age who is determined to 10 11 be eligible for medical assistance under this chapter. The rules 12 shall provide that the child remains eligible for medical assistance, without additional review by the commission and 13 14 regardless of changes in the child's resources or income, until the earlier of: 15

16 (1) the <u>first anniversary of</u> [<del>end of the six-month</del> 17 <del>period following</del>] the date on which the child's eligibility was 18 determined; or

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(2) the child's 19th birthday.

SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the

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1 waiver or authorization is granted.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
