- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 141.001, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to read as follows:
- 7 (a-1) For purposes of satisfying the continuous residency
- 8 requirement of Subsection (a)(5), a person who claims an intent to
- 9 return to a residence after a temporary absence may establish that
- 10 <u>intent only if the person:</u>
- 11 (1) has made a reasonable and substantive attempt to
- 12 effectuate that intent; and
- (2) has a legal right and the practical ability to
- 14 return to the residence.
- 15 <u>(a-2)</u> Subsection (a-1) does not apply to a person displaced
- 16 from the person's residence due to a declared local, state, or
- 17 national disaster.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a candidate in an
- 19 election held on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2020.
