- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.04, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 7 (h) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsection (a)(3)
- 8 that the written rental agreement described by that subsection is a
- 9 rental-purchase agreement. For purposes of this subsection,
- 10 "rental-purchase agreement" means an agreement under which an
- 11 individual may use personal property for personal, family, or
- 12 household purposes for an initial rental period and that:
- 13 (1) is automatically renewable with each payment after
- 14 the initial rental period; and
- 15 (2) permits the individual to become the owner of the
- 16 property.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 18 offense committed before, on, or after the effective date of this
- 19 Act. However, a final conviction for an offense under Section
- 20 31.04, Penal Code, that exists on the effective date of this Act
- 21 remains unaffected by this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
