## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the calculation of charges for a gas utility customer
- 3 after a leak is detected.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 104, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 104.2571 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 104.2571. ADJUSTMENT OF CHARGES ON DETECTION OF LEAK.
- 8 (a) A gas distribution utility that detects a leak in the utility's
- 9 <u>distribution system shall recompute charges for customers not later</u>
- 10 than the 60th day after the date the leak was detected to ensure
- 11 that the customers are not charged for gas that was not delivered as
- 12 <u>a result of the leak</u>.
- 13 (b) The regulatory authority may adopt rules necessary to
- 14 <u>implement this section</u>.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
