- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 773, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 773.1151 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 773.1151. USE OF TELEMEDICINE MEDICAL SERVICE BY
- 8 CERTAIN TRAUMA FACILITIES. (a) In this section, "telemedicine
- 9 medical service" has the meaning assigned by Section 111.001,
- 10 Occupations Code.
- 11 (b) A health care facility located in a county with a
- 12 population of less than 30,000 may satisfy a Level IV trauma
- 13 <u>facility designation requirement relating to physicians through</u>
- 14 the use of telemedicine medical service in which an on-call
- 15 physician who has special competence in the care of critically
- 16 injured patients provides patient assessment, diagnosis,
- 17 consultation, or treatment or transfers medical data to a
- 18 physician, advanced practice registered nurse, or physician
- 19 assistant located at the facility.
- 20 <u>(c) In establishing the requirements for designating a</u>
- 21 <u>facility as a Level IV trauma facility, the executive commissioner</u>
- 22 may not adopt rules that:
- 23 (1) require the physical presence or physical
- 24 availability of a physician who has special competence in the care

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- 1 of critically injured patients; or
- 2 (2) prohibit the use of telemedicine medical service
- 3 that meets the requirements of Subsection (b).
- 4 SECTION 2. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 5 Human Services Commission shall adopt rules to implement Section
- 6 773.1151, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, not later
- 7 than December 1, 2019.
- 8 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding Section 773.1151, Health and
- 9 Safety Code, as added by this Act, a health care facility located in
- 10 a county with a population of less than 30,000 may use telemedicine
- 11 medical service to satisfy a Level IV trauma facility designation
- 12 requirement only on or after January 1, 2020.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
