- 1 years, had been paid a salary at the lowest amount provided by the
- 2 General Appropriations Act for a position of peace officer, jailer,
- 3 county jailer or guard, or employee of the Texas Department of
- 4 Criminal Justice, as described by Section 615.003(1), (4), [or]
- 5 (6), or (7), and had been eligible to retire under the Employees
- 6 Retirement System of Texas.
- 7 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
- 8 payment of assistance to survivors of certain law enforcement
- 9 officers and employees on or after the effective date of this Act
- 10 regardless of the date the officer or employee died.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
