## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the model training curriculum and required training for
- 3 school district peace officers and school resource officers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.0812, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 37.0812. TRAINING POLICY: SCHOOL DISTRICT PEACE
- 8 OFFICERS AND SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS. A school district [with an
- 9 enrollment of 30,000 or more students] that commissions a school
- 10 district peace officer or at which a school resource officer
- 11 provides law enforcement shall adopt a policy requiring the officer
- 12 to complete the education and training program required by Section
- 13 1701.263, Occupations Code.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 1701.263(b), Occupations Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (b) The commission by rule shall require a school district
- 17 peace officer or a school resource officer who is commissioned by or
- 18 who provides law enforcement at a school district [ $\frac{\text{with an}}{\text{c}}$ ]
- 19 enrollment of 30,000 or more students] to successfully complete an
- 20 education and training program described by this section not later
- 21 than 180 [before or within 120] days after [of] the officer's
- 22 commission by or placement in the district or a campus of the
- 23 district. The program must:
- 24 (1) consist of at least 16 hours of training;

- 1 (2) be approved by the commission; and
- 2 (3) provide training in accordance with the curriculum
- 3 developed under Section 1701.262 in each subject area listed in
- 4 Subsection (c) of that section.
- 5 SECTION 3. (a) Notwithstanding Section 1701.263(b),
- 6 Occupations Code, as amended by this Act, a school district peace
- 7 officer or school resource officer who commences employment with or
- 8 commences providing law enforcement at a school district with an
- 9 enrollment of fewer than 30,000 students on a date occurring before
- 10 September 1, 2019, shall complete the training required by Section
- 11 1701.263, Occupations Code, as amended by this Act, as soon as
- 12 practicable and not later than August 31, 2020. This subsection
- 13 does not apply to an officer who is exempt from the training
- 14 established under Section 1701.263, Occupations Code, as amended by
- 15 this Act, because the officer has completed the training described
- 16 by Subsection (b-1) of that section.
- 17 (b) Not later than October 1, 2019, a school district with
- 18 an enrollment of fewer than 30,000 students shall adopt the
- 19 training policy for school district peace officers and school
- 20 resource officers required by Section 37.0812, Education Code, as
- 21 amended by this Act.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
