SECTION 1. Section 325.006, Business & Commerce Code, is
amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (f) to
read as follows:

- 8 (c) The court may increase the amount of an award of actual 9 damages in an action brought under this section to an amount not to 10 exceed three times the actual damages sustained if the court finds 11 that the violation:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> has reoccurred with sufficient frequency to 13 constitute a pattern or practice; or
- 14 (2) adversely affected an elderly individual.
- (f) In this section, "elderly individual" has the meaning assigned by Section 22.04, Penal Code.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
