4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 325.006, Business & Commerce Code, is
6	amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (f) to
7	read as follows:
8	(c) The court may increase the amount of an award of actual
9	damages in an action brought under this section to an amount not to
10	exceed three times the actual damages sustained if the court finds
11	that the violation:
12	(1) has reoccurred with sufficient frequency to
13	constitute a pattern or practice <u>; or</u>
14	(2) adversely affected an elderly individual.
15	(f) In this section, "elderly individual" has the meaning
16	assigned by Section 22.04, Penal Code.
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
