## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the right to vacate and avoid residential lease
- 3 liability following the occurrence of family violence.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 92.016, Property Code, is amended by 5
- amending Subsections (b), (c), and (c-1) and adding Subsection 6
- (b-1) to read as follows: 7
- (b) A tenant may terminate the tenant's 8 rights
- obligations under a lease and may vacate the dwelling and avoid 9
- liability for future rent and any other sums due under the lease for 10
- 11 terminating the lease and vacating the dwelling before the end of
- 12 the lease term if the tenant complies with Subsection (c).
- 13 (b-1) A tenant may obtain relief under Subsection (b) if the
- 14 tenant [and] provides the landlord or the landlord's agent a copy of
- one or more of the following orders protecting the tenant or an 15
- occupant from family violence: 16
- (1) a temporary injunction issued under Subchapter F, 17
- Chapter 6, Family Code; 18
- (2) a temporary ex parte order issued under Chapter 19
- 83, Family Code; [or] 20
- 21 (3) a protective order issued under Chapter 85, Family
- 22 Code; or
- 23 (4) a magistrate's order for emergency protection
- 24 under Article 17.292, Code of Criminal Procedure.

- 1 (c) A tenant may exercise the rights to terminate the lease
- 2 under Subsection (b), vacate the dwelling before the end of the
- 3 lease term, and avoid liability beginning on the date after all of
- 4 the following events have occurred:
- 5 (1) a judge or magistrate, as applicable, signs an
- 6 order described by Subsection (b-1) [(b)];
- 7 (2) the tenant provides a copy of the relevant
- 8 documentation described by Subsection (b-1) [\(\frac{(b)}{b}\)] to the landlord;
- 9 (3) the tenant provides written notice of termination
- 10 of the lease to the landlord on or before the 30th day before the
- 11 date the lease terminates;
- 12 (4) the 30th day after the date the tenant provided
- 13 notice under Subdivision (3) expires; and
- 14 (5) the tenant vacates the dwelling.
- 15 (c-1) If the family violence is committed by a cotenant or
- 16 occupant of the dwelling, a tenant may exercise the right to
- 17 terminate the lease under the procedures provided by Subsection
- 18 (b-1)(1), (3), or (4)  $[\frac{(b)(1) \text{ or } (3)}{(b)}]$  and Subsection (c), except
- 19 that the tenant is not required to provide the notice described by
- 20 Subsection (c)(3).
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 92.016, Property Code, as amended by
- 22 this Act, applies only to a lease entered into or renewed on or
- 23 after the effective date of this Act. A lease entered into or
- 24 renewed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 25 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 26 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
