- 2 relating to a divorce on the ground of insupportability.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 6.001, Family Code, is amended to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Sec. 6.001. INSUPPORTABILITY. On the petition of either
- 7 party to a marriage, the court may grant a divorce without regard to
- 8 fault if both parties to the marriage agree that the marriage has
- 9 become insupportable because of discord or conflict of
- 10 personalities that destroys the legitimate ends of the marital
- 11 relationship and prevents any reasonable expectation of
- 12 reconciliation.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to a suit for divorce that is filed on or after the effective date of
- 15 this Act. A suit for divorce filed before the effective date of
- 16 this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
- 17 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 18 effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
