H.B. No. 953

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to certain contributions by an open-enrollment charter
3 school to the Teacher Retirement System of Texas.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 825.405, Government Code, is amended by
6 adding Subsection (a-1) and amending Subsections (b), (e), and (f)
7 to read as follows:

8 (a-1) For members who are employed by an open-enrollment
9 charter school and who would be entitled to a minimum salary under
10 Section 21.402, Education Code, if employed by a school district,
11 the charter school shall pay the state's contribution on the
12 portion of the member's salary that exceeds the applicable
13 statutory minimum salary under that section.

14 (b) For purposes of Subsection (a) [~~this section~~]:

15 (1) the statutory minimum salary for certain school
16 personnel under Section 21.402, Education Code, is the salary
17 provided by that section multiplied by the cost of education
18 adjustment applicable under Section 42.102, Education Code, to the
19 district in which the member is employed; and

20 (2) the statutory minimum salary for members who would
21 have been entitled to the minimum salary for certain school
22 personnel under former Section 16.056, Education Code, as that
23 section existed on January 1, 1995, is a minimum salary computed in
24 the same manner as the minimum salary for certain school personnel

1 under Section 21.402, Education Code, multiplied by the cost of
2 education adjustment applicable under Section 42.102, Education
3 Code, to the district in which the member is employed.

4 (e) After the end of each school year, the retirement system
5 shall certify to the commissioner of education:

6 (1) the names of any employers [~~employing districts~~]
7 that have failed to remit, within the period required by Section
8 825.408, all contributions required under this section for the
9 school year; and

10 (2) the amounts of the unpaid contributions.

11 (f) If the commissioner of education receives a
12 certification under Subsection (e), the commissioner shall direct
13 the comptroller of public accounts to withhold the amount
14 certified, plus interest computed at the rate and in the manner
15 provided by Section 825.408, from the first state money payable to
16 the employer [~~school district~~]. The amount withheld shall be
17 deposited to the credit of the appropriate accounts of the
18 retirement system.

19 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
20 school year.

21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
