No. 961 1 serves on a volunteer basis as a member of a concussion oversight team for a school district or open-enrollment charter school. 2 3 (e) For purposes of Subsection (c): 4 (1) a coach must take a course described by Subsection 5 (a); 6 (2) an athletic trainer must take: 7 a course described by Subsection (b); or (A) 8 (B) a course concerning the subject matter of concussions that has been approved for continuing education credit 9 by the appropriate licensing authority for the profession; and 10 <u>school nurse o</u>r 11 (3) a licensed health care 12 professional, other than an athletic trainer, must take: a course described by Subsection (a) or (b); 13 (A) 14 or 15 (B) a course concerning the subject matter of concussions that has been approved for continuing education credit 16 17 by the appropriate licensing authority for the profession. A school nurse or licensed health care professional who 18 (g) is not in compliance with the training requirements under this 19 section may not serve on a concussion oversight team in any 20 capacity. 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 25 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
