(a) In this section, "noxious brush" means brush designated by the board 19 as an eligible brush species detrimental to water conservation for 20 purposes of implementing the state water supply enhancement plan. 21 22 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a municipality or county 23 may not adopt or enforce an ordinance, order, rule, or other regulation that prohibits or limits the removal by a landowner of 24
