A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to public school safety measures and procedures.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 37.108(b), Education Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:

6 (b) At least once every <u>two</u> [three] years, each school 7 district or public junior college district shall conduct a safety 8 and security audit of the district's facilities. To the extent 9 possible, a district shall follow safety and security audit 10 procedures developed by the Texas School Safety Center or a 11 comparable public or private entity.

SECTION 2. Sections 38.022(a) and (c), Education Code, are amended to read as follows:

14 (a) A school district shall [may] require a person who enters a district campus for a purpose other than to attend a 15 16 school-sponsored event that is open to the public to display the person's driver's license or another form of identification 17 containing the person's photograph issued by a governmental entity. 18 A school district shall [may] verify whether a person 19 (c) who visits [visitor to] a district campus for a purpose other than 20 21 to attend a school-sponsored event that is open to the public is a sex offender registered with the computerized central database 22 23 maintained by the Department of Public Safety as provided by Article 62.005, Code of Criminal Procedure, or any other database 24

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1 accessible by the district.

2 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020 3 school year.

4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
