A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a women veterans suicide tracking system and required
3	reporting of women veteran suicides by certain persons.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 434.217 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 434.217. WOMEN VETERANS SUICIDE TRACKING SYSTEM;
8	REQUIRED REPORTING OF CERTAIN SUICIDES. (a) The program, in
9	collaboration with the United States Department of Veterans
10	Affairs, shall develop and maintain a system for tracking the
11	number of suicides of women veterans in this state and determining
12	the number of those women veterans who received services from the
13	United States Department of Veterans Affairs. The tracking system
14	<pre>must include data:</pre>
15	(1) available from the United States Department of
16	Veterans Affairs; and

- 17 (2) reported to the program under Subsection (b).
- 18 <u>(b) A person who knows that the cause of death for a woman</u>
 19 <u>veteran is suicide shall report the suicide to the program and</u>
 20 <u>provide any information the person may have that may assist the</u>
 21 program in determining whether the woman received services from the
- 22 United States Department of Veterans Affairs.
- 23 <u>(c) The following persons shall provide to the program in</u> 24 accordance with Subsection (b) any relevant information the person

- 1 obtains related to the suicide death of a woman veteran:
- 2 (1) a medical examiner or a justice of the peace who is
- 3 <u>acting as a coroner;</u>
- 4 (2) a health care facility licensed under Subtitle B,
- 5 Title 4, Health and Safety Code; or
- 6 (3) a mental health facility as defined by Section
- 7 <u>571.003</u>, Health and Safety Code.
- 8 <u>(d) Information about the suicide of a woman veteran</u>
- 9 obtained under this chapter is confidential and is not subject to
- 10 disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, is not subject to
- 11 subpoena, and may not otherwise be released or made public.
- 12 (e) Not later than December 31 of each year, the program
- 13 shall submit to the legislature a report that includes:
- 14 (1) the number of suicides of women veterans that were
- 15 reported to the program under this section during the preceding
- 16 year;
- 17 (2) the number of women described by Subdivision (1)
- 18 who received services from the United States Department of Veterans
- 19 Affairs;
- 20 (3) information on whether the suicide rate of women
- 21 veterans in this state is decreasing or increasing;
- 22 (4) an evaluation of the effectiveness of statewide
- 23 prevention and awareness campaigns in decreasing the number of
- 24 suicides by women veterans in this state; and
- 25 (5) recommendations for improving the effectiveness
- 26 of statewide prevention and awareness campaigns.
- SECTION 2. Not later than December 31, 2019, the Texas Women

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- 1 Veterans Program shall develop the tracking system required by
- 2 Section 434.217, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding Section 434.217, Government
- 4 Code, as added by this Act:
- 5 (1) a person is not required to comply with Section
- 6 434.217(c) until January 1, 2020; and
- 7 (2) the Texas Women Veterans Program is not required
- 8 to submit a report required by Section 434.217(e) to the
- 9 legislature until December 31, 2020.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
