5	SECTION 1. Section 531.02164, Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
7	(c-1) Notwithstanding Subsection $(c)(1)$ , the program
8	required under this section must also provide that home
9	telemonitoring services are available to pediatric persons who:
10	(1) are being concurrently treated by at least three
11	medical specialists;
12	(2) are diagnosed with end-stage solid organ disease;
13	(3) have received an organ transplant; or
14	(4) require mechanical ventilation.
15	SECTION 2. Section 531.02176, Government Code, is repealed.
16	SECTION 3. The executive commissioner of the Health and
17	Human Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to
18	implement Section $531.02164(c-1)$ , Government Code, as added by this
19	Act, not later than December 1, 2019.
20	SECTION 4. If before implementing any provision of this Act
21	a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
22	federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
23	the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
