AN ACT

2 relating to extensions of an expired permit for the transfer of

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 36.122, Water Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsections (j-1), (j-2), (r), and (s) and amending Subsection (k)
- 7 to read as follows:

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- 8 (j-1) A district shall extend a term under Subsection (i)(2)
- 9 or (j) on or before its expiration in the manner prescribed by
- 10 <u>Section 36.1145:</u>
- 11 (1) to a term that is not shorter than the term of an
- 12 operating permit for the production of water to be transferred that
- 13 <u>is in effect at the time of the extension; and</u>
- 14 (2) for each additional term for which that operating
- 15 permit for production is renewed under Section 36.1145 or remains
- 16 <u>in effect under Section 36.1146.</u>
- 17 <u>(j-2)</u> A permit extended under Subsection (j-1) continues to
- 18 be subject to conditions contained in the permit as issued before
- 19 the extension.
- 20 (k) Notwithstanding the period specified <u>under Subsection</u>
- 21 [in Subsections] (i), [and] (j), or (j-1) during which water may be
- 22 transferred under a permit, a district may periodically review the
- 23 amount of water that may be transferred under the permit and may
- 24 limit the amount if additional factors considered in Subsection (f)

- 1 warrant the limitation, subject to Subsection (c). The review
- 2 described by this subsection may take place not more frequently
- 3 than the period provided for the review or renewal of regular
- 4 permits issued by the district. In its determination of whether to
- 5 renew a permit issued under this section, the district shall
- 6 consider relevant and current data for the conservation of
- 7 groundwater resources and shall consider the permit in the same
- 8 manner it would consider any other permit in the district.
- 9 (r) The district may grant or deny an application to extend
- 10 a term under Subsection (i)(2) or (j) submitted under this section
- 11 only using rules that were in effect at the time the application was
- 12 submitted.
- 13 (s) An application to extend a term under Subsection (i)(2)
- 14 or (j) is governed solely by district rules consistent with
- 15 Subsection (j-1).
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 17 the term of a permit issued under Sections 36.122(i) and (j), Water
- 18 Code, that expires after September 1, 2019.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
