A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

	AN ACT

- 2 relating to payments to school districts for certain special
- 3 education evaluations.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 29.0042 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 29.0042. PAYMENTS FOR FULL INDIVIDUAL AND INITIAL
- 8 EVALUATIONS. (a) Each school year from funds available to the
- 9 agency for the purpose, a school district is entitled to receive a
- 10 \$1,000 payment for each full individual and initial evaluation the
- 11 district conducts under Section 29.004 during that school year.
- 12 Payments authorized under this section are in addition to other
- 13 funding the district receives through other provisions of this
- 14 code, including the allotment provided under Section 42.152.
- 15 (b) To receive payment under this section for a school year,
- 16 a school district must submit to the commissioner on or before a
- 17 date established by commissioner rule:
- 18 (1) a list that identifies each evaluation conducted
- 19 by the district under Section 29.004 for the year; and
- 20 (2) documentation sufficient to verify each
- 21 evaluation for which the district requests a payment.
- 22 <u>(c) The commissioner shall approve an evaluation for</u>
- 23 payment under this section if the commissioner determines a school
- 24 district's documentation submitted under Subsection (b) for the

- 1 <u>evaluation is sufficient.</u>
- 2 (d) If the funds available for a school year are not
- 3 sufficient to make a full \$1,000 payment for each evaluation
- 4 approved for payment for that year, the commissioner shall reduce
- 5 the payment amount provided for each evaluation approved
- 6 proportionately to an amount equal to the total amount of funds
- 7 available for payments under this section divided by the total
- 8 number of evaluations approved.
- 9 <u>(e) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to</u>
- 10 implement this section, including rules:
- 11 (1) to provide guidance for submitting a request for
- 12 payment, including submitting documentation for verification of an
- 13 evaluation under Subsection (b); and
- 14 (2) to ensure this section complies with federal law
- 15 regarding confidentiality of student medical or educational
- 16 <u>information</u>, including the Health Insurance Portability and
- 17 Accountability Act of 1996 (42 U.S.C. Section 1320d et seq.) and the
- 18 Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (20 U.S.C.
- 19 Section 1232g), and any state law relating to the privacy of student
- 20 information.
- 21 SECTION 2. (a) This Act applies beginning with the
- 22 2019-2020 school year.
- 23 (b) As soon as practicable after the effective date of this
- 24 Act, the commissioner of education shall adopt rules necessary to
- 25 implement Section 29.0042, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- 26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
