5	SECTION 1. (a) In this Act, "improvement" has the meaning
6	assigned by Section 221.001, Transportation Code.
7	(b) The Texas Department of Transportation shall conduct a
8	comprehensive study of the feasibility of and the costs and
9	logistical matters associated with improvements that:
10	(1) extend Interstate Highway 27:
11	(A) from its northern terminus to Dumas;
12	(B) from Dumas to Stratford; and
13	(C) from Stratford to the Oklahoma state border;
14	and
15	(2) extend Interstate Highway 27:
16	(A) from its northern terminus to Dumas;
17	(B) from Dumas to Dalhart; and
18	(C) from Dalhart to the New Mexico state border.
19	(c) Not later than January 1, 2021, the Texas Department of
20	Transportation shall submit a report on the results of the study to
21	the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of
22	representatives, and the presiding officer of each standing
23	committee of the legislature with jurisdiction over transportation
24	matters.

1 (d) This Act expires August 31, 2021.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
