A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to an exemption from the sales tax for certain beer or ale
- 3 sold on July 4.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 151.3155 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.3155. BEER OR ALE ON JULY 4. The sale of beer or
- 8 ale is exempted from the taxes imposed by this chapter if:
- 9 <u>(1) the sale takes place on July 4; and</u>
- 10 (2) the seller holds a wine and beer retailer's
- 11 off-premise permit under Chapter 26, Alcoholic Beverage Code.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 13 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- 14 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 15 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
- 16 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 17 the liability for those taxes.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
