- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 13.002(a) and (b), Election Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person desiring to register to vote must submit an
- 8 application to the registrar of the county in which the person
- 9 resides. Except as provided by Subsection (e), an application must
- 10 be submitted by personal delivery or  $[\tau]$  by mail  $[\tau]$  or by telephonic
- 11 facsimile machine in accordance with Sections 13.143(d) and (d-2)].
- 12 (b) A registration application must be in writing and signed
- 13 by the applicant using ink on paper. An electronic signature or
- 14 photocopied signature is not permitted.
- SECTION 2. Section 13.143(d), Election Code, is amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 (d) For purposes of determining the effective date of a
- 18 registration, an application submitted by [÷
- 19  $\left[\frac{1}{2}\right]$  mail is considered to be submitted to the
- 20 registrar on the date it is placed with postage prepaid and properly
- 21 addressed in the United States mail[; or
- 22 [(2) telephonic facsimile machine is considered to be
- 23 submitted to the registrar on the date the transmission is received
- 24 by the registrar, subject to Subsection (d-2)].

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 84.001(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 (b) An application must be in writing and signed by the
- 4 applicant using ink on paper. An electronic signature or
- 5 photocopied signature is not permitted.
- 6 SECTION 4. Section 13.143(d-2), Election Code, is repealed.
- 7 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 8 application for voter registration or for a ballot to be voted by
- 9 mail submitted on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 10 application for voter registration or for a ballot to be voted by
- 11 mail submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 12 the law in effect when the application was submitted, and the former
- 13 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
