1-20 relating to the powers of certain county assistance districts.
 1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-22 SECTION 1. Section 387.003, Local Government Code, is
 1-23 amended by adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows:
 1-24 (a-2) A district created by a county with a population of
 1-25 more than 580,000 that borders a county with a population of more
 1-26 than four million may perform inside or outside the district a
 1-27 function that benefits the district and that the county is
 1-28 authorized to perform, including a function described by Subsection
 1-29 (a-1).
 1-30 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
