## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the registration of voters at a polling place and 3 related procedures. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 63, Election Code, is amended by adding Section 63.013 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 63.013. REGISTRATION AT POLLING PLACE; VOTING 7 PROCEDURES. (a) Other applicable provisions of this code apply to 8 9 the conduct of voting and to the registration of voters under this section to the extent those provisions do not conflict with this 10 section. 11 12 (b) A person who would be eligible to vote in an election under Section 11.001, but for the requirement to be a registered 13 14 voter, shall be accepted for voting in the precinct of the person's residence if, on the day the person offers to vote, the person: 15 16 (1) submits a voter registration application that complies with Section 13.002 to an elected official at the polling 17 place; and 18 (2) presents as proof of identification: 19 (A) a Texas driver's license, including a 20 temporary license or instruction permit, or personal 21 identification card issued to the person by the Department of 22 23 Public Safety that states the person's current address on the day 24 the person seeks to vote; or

1	(B) a utility bill addressed to the person dated
2	not earlier than the 30th day before the date the person seeks to
3	vote, and:
4	(i) a Texas driver's license, including a
5	temporary license or instruction permit, or personal
6	identification card issued to the person by the Department of
7	Public Safety, regardless of whether the address stated on the
8	license or card is current on the day the person seeks to vote; or
9	(ii) a valid United States passport issued
10	to the person; or
11	(iii) a valid United States military
12	identification card that contains the person's photograph.
13	(c) Persons voting under this section shall be processed
14	separately at the polling place from persons who are voting under
15	regular procedures.
16	(d) The Secretary of State shall adopt rules to ensure the
17	accountability of election officers and to fairly implement this
18	section.
19	SECTION 2. Section 85.031(a), Election Code, is amended to
20	read as follows:
21	(a) For each person entitled to vote an early voting ballot
22	by personal appearance <u>or entitled to register at a polling place</u> ,
23	the early voting clerk shall follow the procedure for accepting <u>or</u>
24	registering a regular voter on election day, with the modifications
25	necessary for the conduct of early voting.
26	SECTION 3. The secretary of state shall adopt rules as
27	required by Section 63.013, Election Code, as added by this Act, not

1 later than January 1, 2020.

2 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 3 an election for which early voting by personal appearance begins on 4 or after January 1, 2020.

5 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect January 1, 2020.
