## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the adjustment of fees for vehicles stored at vehicle
3	storage facilities; authorizing fee increases.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2303.155, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (h) and (i) to
7	read as follows:
8	(a) For the purposes of this section, "governmental vehicle
9	storage facility" means a garage, parking lot, or other facility
10	that is:
11	$\underline{(1)}$ [ $\overline{(A)}$ ] owned by a governmental entity; and
12	(2) [ $(B)$ ] used to store or park at least 10 vehicles
13	each year.
14	(h) The commission shall biennially:
15	(1) adjust fees under this section according to the
16	percentage increase or decrease, if any, in the Consumer Price
17	Index for Urban Wage Earners and Clerical Workers (CPI-W) most
18	recently published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United
19	States Department of Labor;

- 20 (2) notify vehicle storage facilities licensed under
- 21 this chapter of the adjustment; and
- 22 (3) allow a reasonable period for implementation of
- 23 the adjustment.
- 24 <u>(i) If a fee is decreased under Subsection (h), the operator</u>

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- 1 of a vehicle storage facility or governmental vehicle storage
- 2 <u>facility shall begin charging the new fee amount on the effective</u>
- 3 date of the decrease. If a fee is increased, the operator may begin
- 4 charging the new amount at any time on or after the effective date
- 5 of the increase.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
