A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the transportation or storage of a handgun or other 1-19 1-20 firearm or ammunition by a handgun license holder in a school 1-21 parking area.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 37.0815(a), Education Code, is amended 1-24 to read as follows:

1-25 (a) A school district or open-enrollment charter school may not prohibit a person, including a school employee, who holds a license to carry a handgun under Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code, from transporting or storing a handgun or other 1-26 1-27 1-28 1-29 firearm or ammunition in a locked, privately owned or leased motor vehicle in a parking lot, parking garage, or other parking area provided by the district or charter school <u>and may not regulate the</u> 1-30 1-31 manner in which the handgun, firearm, or ammunition is stored in the vehicle, provided that the handgun, firearm, or ammunition is not 1-32 1-33 in plain view. 1-34

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020 1-36 school year.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-37 1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-40 1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
