Section 814.103, Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 814.103. SERVICE RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR ELECTED CLASS 7 SERVICE. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the standard 8 service retirement annuity for service credited in the elected 9 for a person described by Section 10 class of membership 812.002(a)(1), other than the lieutenant governor, or a person 11 described by Section 812.002(a)(3) is an amount equal to the number 12 of years of service credit in that class, times two percent of the 13 state salary, excluding longevity pay payable under Section 14 659.0445 and as adjusted from time to time, being paid a district 15 16 judge. (b) The standard service retirement annuity for service 17 credited in the elected class computed under Subsection (a) may not 18 exceed at any time 100 percent of the state salary being paid a 19 20 district judge. 21 (c) The standard service retirement annuity for service credited in the elected class of membership for the lieutenant 22

retirement annuity of a full-time certified classroom teacher who 1 retired from employment with the public free schools of this state 2 in the preceding calendar year as determined by the Teacher 3 4 Retirement System of Texas. 5 (d) Not later than February 1 of each year, the Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall make the determination required 6 7 under Subsection (c) with respect to the preceding calendar year 8 and notify the lieutenant governor, members of the legislature, and the retirement system of its determination. 9

10 SECTION 2. Section 814.103, Government Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to the standard service retirement annuity 11 of a member of the elected class who is first eligible to become a 12 member of the elected class on or after January 1, 2020. 13 The 14 standard service retirement annuity of a member of the elected 15 class who is first eligible to become a member of the elected class before January 1, 2020, is governed by the law as it existed 16 17 immediately before that date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 18

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the date on which the 20 constitutional amendment proposed by the 86th Legislature, Regular 21 Session, 2019, setting the salaries of members of the legislature 22 and the lieutenant governor based on the average public school 23 teacher salary in this state is approved by the voters. If that 24 amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
