## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to carrying a handgun during a state of disaster. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 46.15, Penal Code, is amended by adding 4 5 Subsections (k) and (l) to read as follows: 6 (k) Section 46.02 does not apply to a person who carries a 7 handgun if: (1) the person carries the handgun while: 8 9 (A) evacuating from an area subject to a mandatory evacuation order issued during a state of disaster 10 declared under Section 418.014, Government Code, or a local state 11 of disaster declared under Section 418.108, Government Code; or 12 13 (B) reentering that area following the person's 14 evacuation; (2) not more than 168 hours have elapsed since the 15 16 evacuation was ordered or more than 168 hours have elapsed since the evacuation order was issued and the governor has extended the 17 period during which a person may carry a handgun; and 18 19 (3) the person is not prohibited by state or federal law from possessing a firearm. 20 (1) Sections 46.02, 46.03(a)(1), (a)(2), (a)(3), and 21 (a)(4), and 46.035(a), (a-1), (a-2), (a-3), (b)(1), (b)(4), (b)(5), 22 23 and (b)(6) do not apply to a person who carries a handgun if: 24 (1) the person carries the handgun on the premises, as

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defined by the statute providing the applicable offense, of a 1 location operating as an emergency shelter during a state of 2 disaster declared under <u>Section 418.014</u>, <u>Government Code</u>, or <u>a</u> 3 local state of disaster declared under Section 418.108, Government 4 5 Code; 6 (2) the owner, controller, or operator of the premises 7 or a person acting with the apparent authority of the owner, controller, or operator, authorized the carrying of the handgun; 8 and 9 10 (3) the person is not prohibited by state or federal 11 law from possessing a firearm. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 12 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 13 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 14 15 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 16 For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 17 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was 18 committed before that date. 19 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
