4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 531.024442 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 531.024442. MEDICAID BUY-IN PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN
8	PERSONS WITH INCREASED HOUSEHOLD INCOME FROM EMPLOYMENT. (a) The
9	commission shall operate a Medicaid buy-in program for Medicaid
10	recipients:
11	(1) who are not eligible for a Medicaid buy-in program
12	established under Section 531.02444; and
13	(2) whose eligibility for Medicaid is otherwise being

- 14 terminated solely because of an increase in household income
- 15 received from employment.
- 16 (b) The program under this section must be substantively
- 17 identical to the Medicaid buy-in programs for persons with
- 18 <u>disabilities established under Section 531.02444</u>, except to the
- 19 extent that programmatic differences are appropriate because of the
- 20 populations served by the programs.
- 21 (c) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules for
- 22 participation in the program under this section that provide for:
- (1) eligibility requirements, including household
- 24 income limits for participation; and

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- 1 (2) requirements for program participants to pay
- 2 premiums or cost-sharing payments.
- 3 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2020, the executive
- 4 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 5 adopt the rules required by Section 531.024442, Government Code, as
- 6 added by this Act, and the commission shall implement the program
- 7 required by that section.
- 8 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 9 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 10 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 11 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 12 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 13 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
