4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 61.9773, Education Code, is amended by

6 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

(a-1) An agreement under this section must allow a student, 7 upon completion of an undergraduate degree program and before 8 entering into a commitment or contract for military service 9 described by Subsection (a)(3), to complete a graduate or 10 postgraduate degree program relevant to that military service at a 11 public or private institution of higher education in this state. 12 The board shall adopt rules for the administration of this 13 subsection, including rules for determining whether a degree 14

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies beginning with a Texas Armed Services Scholarship awarded for the 2019-2020 academic year. A Texas Armed Services Scholarship awarded for an academic year before that academic year is covered by the law in effect when the scholarship was awarded, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall adopt rules for the administration of Section 61.9773(a-1), Education Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after
