A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the deadline for submitting an application for a ballot
- 3 to be voted by mail.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 84.007(c), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (c) Except as provided by Section 86.0015(b), an
- 8 application may be submitted at any time in the year of the election
- 9 for which a ballot is requested, but not later than 5 p.m. [the
- 10 close of regular business in the early voting clerk's office or 12
- 11 noon, whichever is later, on the 11th day before election day
- 12 unless that day is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal state or national
- 13 holiday, in which case the last day is the first preceding regular
- 14 business day. For purposes of this subsection, an application for a
- 15 ballot to be voted by mail deposited in a post office box before the
- 16 post office box is last inspected for removal of mail on the next
- 17 business day after the day described above is considered timely
- 18 <u>submitted.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 84.008(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (a) An applicant for a ballot to be voted by mail may submit
- 22 the application by delivering it in person to the early voting clerk
- 23 if the application is submitted not later than 5 p.m. on the 11th
- 24 day before election day unless that day is a Saturday, Sunday, or

- 2 first preceding regular business day [the close of regular business
- 3 in the clerk's office on the day before the first day of the period
- 4 for early voting by personal appearance].
- 5 SECTION 3. Section 86.0015(b-1), Election Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) An application submitted under this section must be
- 8 submitted before 5 p.m. [the close of regular business in the early
- 9 voting clerk's office or 12 noon, whichever is later, on the 11th
- 10 day before election day unless that day is a Saturday, Sunday, or
- 11 legal state or national holiday, in which case the last day is the
- 12 first preceding regular business day. For purposes of this
- 13 subsection, an application for a ballot to be voted by mail
- 14 deposited in a post office box before the post office box is last
- 15 inspected for removal of mail on the next business day after the day
- 16 <u>described above is considered timely submitted.</u>
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
