- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 2306.67022, Government Code, is amended 4
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 2306.67022. QUALIFIED ALLOCATION PLAN; MANUAL. (a)
- 7 At least biennially, the board shall adopt a qualified allocation
- plan and a corresponding manual to provide information regarding 8
- 9 the administration of and eligibility for the low income housing
- The board may adopt the plan and manual 10 tax credit program.
- annually, as considered appropriate by the board. 11
- 12 (b) The department may require as part of the threshold
- criteria under a qualified allocation plan that a proposed 13
- development satisfy certain criteria relating to educational 14
- quality, as specified by the department in that plan. 15
- 16 (c) The department may not adopt a qualified allocation plan
- that uses a scoring system that awards points to an application 17
- based on criteria relating to the educational quality applicable to 18
- a proposed development site. 19
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to an application for low income housing tax credits that is 21
- submitted to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs 22
- 23 during an application cycle that is based on the 2020 qualified
- allocation plan or a subsequent plan adopted by the governing board 24

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- 1 of the department under Section 2306.67022, Government Code, as
- 2 amended by this Act. An application that is submitted during an
- 3 application cycle that is based on an earlier qualified allocation
- 4 plan is governed by the law in effect on the date the application
- 5 cycle began, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 6 purpose.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
