3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section $545.157(a)$ , Transportation Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	(a) This section applies only to the following vehicles:
7	(1) a stationary authorized emergency vehicle using
8	visual signals that meet the requirements of Sections 547.305 and
9	547.702;
10	(2) a stationary tow truck using equipment authorized
11	by Section 547.305(d); and
12	(3) a Texas Department of Transportation vehicle or a
13	highway maintenance vehicle operated pursuant to a contract awarded
14	under Subchapter A, Chapter 223, not separated from the roadway by a
15	traffic control channelizing device and using visual signals that
16	comply with the standards and specifications adopted under Section
17	547.105.
18	SECTION 2. Section 547.001(2-b), Transportation Code, is
19	amended to read as follows:
20	(2-b) "Highway maintenance vehicle" means a highway or
21	traffic maintenance vehicle designated by the Texas Department of
22	Transportation. The term includes equipment for:
23	(A) road maintenance, including:
24	(i) equipment for snow removal, line

- 1 striping, skid resistance testing, sweeping, [and] spraying, guard
- 2 rail repair, sign maintenance, and temporary traffic control device
- 3 placement or removal;
- 4 (ii) aerial platform lift machines; and
- 5 (iii) road profiler machines; and
- 6 (B) off-road use, including motor graders, road
- 7 rollers, excavators, pneumatic tire equipment, movers, and
- 8 tractors.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
