5	SECTION 1. Chapter 2051, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter E to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER E. NOTICE BY PUBLICATION ON INTERNET FOR POLITICAL
8	SUBDIVISIONS
9	Sec. 2051.151. NOTICE BY PUBLICATION ON INTERNET. A
10	political subdivision may satisfy a requirement in any other law to
11	provide notice by publication in a newspaper by posting the notice
12	continuously from the earliest date provided for in the requirement
13	until the day after the date the action for which notice was
14	required occurs:
15	(1) on its Internet website; or
16	(2) on a social media website if:
17	(A) the political subdivision controls the
18	content of the posting; and
19	(B) the notice is easily found by searching the
20	name of the political subdivision on the Internet.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
