- 2 relating to a study by the Teacher Retirement System of Texas
- 3 regarding the use of health reimbursement accounts in conjunction
- 4 with certain Medicare plans to provide health benefit coverage for

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. STUDY. (a) The Teacher Retirement System of
- 8 Texas shall conduct a study to evaluate the use of health
- 9 reimbursement accounts in conjunction with Medicare plans
- 10 available through the individual marketplace as a means to provide
- 11 health benefit coverage under Chapter 1575, Insurance Code, for
- 12 Medicare-eligible retired school employees and their spouses.
- 13 (b) The evaluation must consider:
- 14 (1) the affordability and availability of Medicare
- 15 plans available through the individual marketplace to
- 16 Medicare-eligible retirees and their spouses in the 2018-2019
- 17 biennium compared to health benefit plans available to those
- 18 retirees and their spouses under Chapter 1575, Insurance Code;
- 19 (2) provider availability under Medicare plans
- 20 available through the individual marketplace; and
- 21 (3) any other items the Teacher Retirement System of
- 22 Texas determines are relevant to the system's long-term ability to
- 23 provide health benefits to Medicare-eligible retirees and their
- 24 spouses considering the demographic, geographic, and socioeconomic

- 1 characteristics of the Medicare-eligible retirees and spouses
- 2 participating in the group program under Chapter 1575, Insurance
- 3 Code.
- 4 SECTION 2. REPORT. Not later than January 1, 2020, the
- 5 Teacher Retirement System of Texas shall submit to the governor,
- 6 lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of representatives, and
- 7 Legislative Budget Board a written report of the study conducted
- 8 under Section 1 of this Act. The report must include the findings
- 9 and legislative recommendations of the Teacher Retirement System of
- 10 Texas.
- 11 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act expires January 1,
- 12 2021.
- 13 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 14 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 15 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 16 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 17 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
