A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to patient medical records regarding maternal death. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter J, Chapter 1001, Health and Safety 4 5 Code, is amended by adding Section 1001.242 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 1001.242. REQUEST FOR MEDICAL RECORDS RELATED TO MATERNAL DEATH. (a) Not later than the 30th business day after 7 receiving a request from the department, a hospital, birthing 8 center, or other custodian of a patient's medical records shall 9 submit to the department the medical records of a patient who was 10 11 pregnant at the time of death or was pregnant at any time in the year 12 preceding the patient's death. 13 (b) Any personally identifying information in a patient's 14 medical records acquired by the department under this section is confidential and is not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552, 15 16 Government Code. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 17

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
