## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to the extended registration of certain vehicles not subject to inspection. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 502, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 502.0024 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 502.0024. EXTENDED REGISTRATION OF CERTAIN VEHICLES 7 NOT SUBJECT TO INSPECTION. (a) Notwithstanding Section 8 9 502.044(c), the department shall develop and implement a system of registration to allow an owner of a vehicle described by Section 10 548.052(3) other than a mobile home to register the vehicle for an 11 12 extended registration period of not more than five years. The owner may select the number of years for registration under this section 13 14 within that range and register the vehicle for that period. Payment for all applicable fees, including registration fees and the fee 15 required by Section 548.510, for the entire registration period 16 selected is due at the time of registration. 17 (b) The fee required by Section 548.510 shall be remitted to 18 the comptroller for deposit in the Texas mobility fund, the general 19 revenue fund, and the clean air account in amounts proportionate to 20 21 the allocation prescribed by Subsection (b) of that section. 22 SECTION 2. Not later than February 1, 2020, the Texas 23 Department of Motor Vehicles shall adopt the system required by

Section 502.0024, Transportation Code, as added by this Act, and

- 1 any rules necessary to implement that section.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
