A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 7.056(e), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (e) Except as provided by Subsection (f), a school campus or
- 8 district may not receive an exemption or waiver under this section
- 9 from:
- 10 (1) a prohibition on conduct that constitutes a
- 11 criminal offense;
- 12 (2) a requirement imposed by federal law or rule,
- 13 including a requirement for special education or bilingual
- 14 education programs; or
- 15 (3) a requirement, restriction, or prohibition
- 16 relating to:
- 17 (A) essential knowledge or skills under Section
- 18 28.002 or high school graduation requirements under Section 28.025;
- 19 (B) public school accountability as provided by
- 20 Subchapters B, C, D, and J, Chapter 39, and Chapter 39A;
- 21 (C) extracurricular activities under Section
- 22 33.081 or participation in a University Interscholastic League
- 23 area, regional, or state competition under Section 33.0812;
- 24 (D) health and safety under Chapter 38;

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- 1 (E) purchasing under Subchapter B, Chapter 44;
- 2 (F) elementary school class size limits, except
- 3 as provided by Section 25.112;
- 4 (G) removal of a disruptive student from the
- 5 classroom under Subchapter A, Chapter 37;
- 6 (H) at-risk programs under Subchapter C, Chapter
- 7 29;
- 8 (I) prekindergarten programs under Subchapter E,
- 9 Chapter 29;
- 10 (J) educator rights and benefits under
- 11 Subchapters A, C, D, E, F, G, and I, Chapter 21, or under Subchapter
- 12 A, Chapter 22;
- 13 (K) special education programs under Subchapter
- 14 A, Chapter 29;
- 15 (L) bilingual education programs under
- 16 Subchapter B, Chapter 29; [ex]
- 17 (M) the requirements for the first day of
- 18 instruction under Section 25.0811; or
- (N) assignment of a student to a teacher under
- 20 Section 28.0215, except as provided by Subsections (c) and (d) of
- 21 that section.
- 22 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
- 23 amended by adding Section 28.0215 to read as follows:
- Sec. 28.0215. REQUIREMENTS FOR ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO
- 25 TEACHERS. (a) This section applies only to a school district with
- 26 <u>an enrollment of 5,000 or more students.</u>
- 27 (b) A student in first through sixth grade who attends an

- 1 elementary school may not be assigned for two consecutive school
- 2 years to a teacher teaching a subject in the foundation curriculum
- 3 under Section 28.002(a)(1) who has less than one year of teaching
- 4 experience and who does not hold the appropriate certificate
- 5 required under Section 21.003 unless:
- 6 (1) the student's parent or other person standing in
- 7 parental relation to the student and a school counselor or school
- 8 administrator agree otherwise regarding assignment of the student
- 9 to the teacher; or
- 10 (2) the assignment of the student to the teacher
- 11 occurs during the first year a student transfers into a school
- 12 district.
- 13 (c) The commissioner may grant a waiver from the
- 14 requirements of this section to a school district if the
- 15 commissioner finds that extreme circumstances in the district
- 16 warrant the waiver. The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary
- 17 to implement this section.
- 18 (d) This section does not apply to a school district
- 19 operating under Chapter 12A.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
