- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 403, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 403.0243 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 403.0243. POLITICAL SUBDIVISION DISASTER EXPENDITURE
- 9 DATABASE. (a) In this section:
- 10 (1) "Disaster" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 11 418.004.

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- 12 (2) "Political subdivision" means a county,
- 13 municipality, school district, junior college district, other
- 14 special district, or other subdivision of state government.
- 15 (b) The comptroller shall establish and maintain on the
- 16 Internet an electronically searchable database that contains the
- 17 following information for each political subdivision:
- 18 <u>(1) the total amount budgeted by the political</u>
- 19 subdivision for disaster preparedness, response, rebuilding, and
- 20 mitigation in the most recent fiscal year of the political
- 21 subdivision that is complete;
- (2) the total amount spent by the political
- 23 <u>subdivision for disaster preparedness, response, rebuilding, and</u>
- 24 mitigation in the most recent fiscal year of the political

- 1 subdivision that is complete; and
- 2 (3) the total amount received by the political
- 3 subdivision for disaster preparedness, response, rebuilding, and
- 4 mitigation in the most recent fiscal year of the political
- 5 subdivision that is complete from the following categories, stated
- 6 as a total amount and a per category amount:
- 7 (A) the federal government;
- 8 (B) the state government;
- 9 (C) another public entity, including another
- 10 political subdivision; and
- 11 (D) a private entity, including an insurance
- 12 company or nonprofit charitable organization.
- 13 (c) The comptroller shall update the information in the
- 14 database for a political subdivision not later than the 45th day
- 15 after the date on which the comptroller receives a report from the
- 16 political subdivision under Subsection (d).
- 17 (d) Each political subdivision shall, at the close of the
- 18 political subdivision's fiscal year, prepare and file with the
- 19 comptroller an annual report that contains for that fiscal year the
- 20 information described by Subsection (b). Each political
- 21 subdivision must file the report required by this subsection in a
- 22 form and in the manner prescribed by the comptroller. The
- 23 comptroller shall prepare a form for the report required by this
- 24 subsection.
- 25 (e) The comptroller shall establish procedures and adopt
- 26 rules to implement this section.
- 27 SECTION 2. The comptroller of public accounts shall:

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- 1 (1) prepare and make available the form required by
- 2 Section 403.0243(d), Government Code, as added by this Act, not
- 3 later than October 1, 2019; and
- 4 (2) establish and post on the Internet the database
- 5 required by Section 403.0243, Government Code, as added by this
- 6 Act, not later than September 1, 2020.
- 7 SECTION 3. The first report required of a political
- 8 subdivision under Section 403.0243(d), Government Code, as added by
- 9 this Act, must be filed with the comptroller of public accounts at
- 10 the close of the political subdivision's 2019 fiscal year.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
