- 7 Sec. 8843.104. PERMIT REQUIRED; EXEMPT USE [WELLS]. (a)
- 8 The district may not require a permit to drill or operate
- 9 [Groundwater withdrawals from the following wells may not be
- 10 regulated, permitted, or metered by the district]:
- 11 (1) a well used for domestic use by a <u>single-family</u>
- 12 [single private] residential household and incapable of producing
- 13 more than 25,000 gallons per day; and
- 14 (2) a well used for agricultural use [conventional
- 15 farming and ranching activities, including such intensive
- 16 operations as aquaculture, livestock feedlots, or poultry
- 17 operations].
- 18 (b) The district may not <u>require a meter on</u> [charge or
- 19 collect a well construction fee for] a well described by Subsection
- 20 <u>(a)</u> $[\frac{(a)(2)}{(a)}]$.
- 21 (c) (b-1) A well owner must obtain a permit and pay any
- 22 required fees, including a well construction fee, before using any
- 23 groundwater withdrawn from a well in the district for purposes
- 24 other than those exempted by this chapter or Chapter 36, Water Code

- 19 (b) The district may not charge for an annual period a

- (2) 25 cents per 1,000 gallons for water used for any
