- 5 SECTION 1. Article 45.041, Code of Criminal Procedure, is

- 7 (e)(1) This subsection applies only to a criminal action in
- 8 which the defendant enters a plea of guilty or nolo contendere in a
- 9 misdemeanor case punishable by fine only.
- 10 (2) A criminal action described by Subdivision (1) is
- 11 considered adjudicated for purposes of appeal, and the judgment and
- 12 <u>sentence in the action is considered rendered, if:</u>

- 2 (b) The addition by this Act of Article 45.041(e), Code of
- 3 Criminal Procedure, is intended to clarify rather than change the
- 4 existing law.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
