1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the application fee for a permit for a municipal solid  
1-23 waste facility; imposing a fee.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety  
1-26 Code, is amended by adding Section 361.0675 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 361.0675. APPLICATION FEE FOR PERMIT FOR MUNICIPAL  
1-28 SOLID WASTE FACILITY. The commission shall charge an applicant for  
1-29 a permit for a municipal solid waste facility an application fee of  
1-30 \$2,000.

1-31 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date  
1-32 of this Act, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality shall  
1-33 adopt or modify any rules necessary to implement the change in law  
1-34 made by this Act.

1-35 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
1-36 to an application for a permit that is submitted to the Texas  
1-37 Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date  
1-38 of this Act. An application for a permit that was submitted to the  
1-39 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality before the effective date  
1-40 of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the  
1-41 application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for  
1-42 that purpose.

1-43 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
