Section 38.111(a), Penal Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 (a) A person commits an offense if the person, while 7 confined in a correctional facility after being charged with or 8 convicted of an offense listed in Article 62.001(5), Code of 9 Criminal Procedure, contacts by letter, telephone, or any other 10 means, either directly or through a third party, a victim of the 11 12 offense or a member of the victim's family, if [+ 13 [(1) the victim was younger than 17 years of age at the 14 time of the commission of the offense for which the person confined; and 15 [(2)] the director of the correctional facility has 16 not, before the person makes contact with the victim: 17 18 (1) [(A)] received written and dated consent to the contact from: 19 20 (A) the victim, if the victim was 17 years of age or older at the time of the commission of the offense for which the 21 person is confined; or 22 23 (B) if the victim was younger than 17 years of age at the time of the commission of the offense for which the person is 24

1 confined: 2 (i) a parent of the victim; 3 (ii) a legal guardian of the victim; 4 (iii) the victim, if the victim is 17 years of age or older at the time of giving the consent; or 5 6 (iv) a member of the victim's family who is 17 years of age or older; and 7 8 (2) [(B)] provided the person with a copy of the 9 consent. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 10 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 11 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 12 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 13 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 14 For 15 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 16 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 17 before that date.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
