- 8 (4-a) "Long-term care facility" means a facility

- 10 $\underline{(4-b)}$ "Peace officer" has the meaning assigned by

- SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 81, Health and Safety
- 14 Code, is amended by adding Sections 81.014 and 81.015 to read as

- 16 Sec. 81.014. LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY INFECTION PREVENTION
- 17 AND CONTROL PROGRAM. (a) Each long-term care facility's infection
- 18 prevention and control program must include:
- (1) monitoring of key infectious agents,
- 20 <u>including multidrug-resistant organisms;</u>
- 21 (2) procedures for communicating the presence of
- 22 multidrug-resistant organism infections when admitting a resident
- 23 to or transferring a resident from the facility; and
- 24 (3) procedures for making rapid influenza diagnostic

- 1 <u>tests available to facility residents.</u>
- 2 (b) Subject to the confidentiality requirements of this
- 3 chapter, the commission shall ensure that each long-term care
- 4 facility's infection prevention and control program includes a
- 5 requirement for the facility to report to the health authority or
- 6 the department when two or more confirmed cases of influenza occur
- 7 among facility residents within a 72-hour period.

- 9 COMMITTEES. (a) The department shall establish a regional
