3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 40, Human Resources Code,
5	is amended by adding Section 40.05291 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 40.05291. CASEWORKER CASELOAD SCORING SYSTEM AND
7	REPORT. (a) The department shall study the development and
8	implementation of a scoring system to ensure equity in the
9	distribution of cases among child protective services caseworkers.
10	As part of the study, the department shall:
11	(1) consider:
12	(A) the procedures for assigning cases;
13	(B) the methods for managing caseloads; and
14	(C) the factors considered in assigning scores to
15	caseloads and assigning cases to caseworkers;
16	(2) determine the average caseload for caseworkers in
17	<pre>each department region;</pre>
18	(3) determine the cost to implement any scoring system
19	developed by the department; and
20	(4) ensure any scoring system developed by the
21	department has the capability of producing monthly reports that
22	include information for each department region.
23	(b) Not later than September 1, 2020, the department shall
24	report the results of the study and any recommendations to the

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- 1 governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of
- 2 representatives, and chairs of the standing committees of the
- 3 senate and house of representatives having primary jurisdiction
- 4 over child protection issues.
- 5 (c) This section expires September 1, 2021.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
