4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 2002, Insurance Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2002.103 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2002.103. DISCLOSURE REGARDING FLOOD COVERAGE
8	REQUIRED. (a) In this section, "residential property insurance"
9	means insurance coverage against damage to or loss of residential
10	real or tangible personal property at a fixed location that is
11	provided through:
12	(1) a homeowners insurance policy, including a tenants
13	insurance policy;
14	(2) a condominium owners insurance policy;
15	(3) a residential fire and allied lines insurance
16	<pre>policy;</pre>
17	(4) a farm and ranch insurance policy; or
18	(5) a farm and ranch owners insurance policy.
19	(b) This section applies to each insurer authorized to
20	engage in the business of residential property insurance in this
21	state, including a county mutual insurance company, farm mutual
22	insurance company, Lloyd's plan, and reciprocal or interinsurance
23	exchange.
24	(c) An insurer that issues or renews a residential property

1 insurance policy that does not provide coverage against loss caused by flooding shall include with the policy documents the following 2 statement in at least 18-point bold type: "FLOOD INSURANCE: YOU MAY 3 NEED TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF FLOOD INSURANCE. YOUR RESIDENTIAL 4 PROPERTY INSURANCE POLICY DOES NOT INCLUDE COVERAGE FOR DAMAGE 5 RESULTING FROM FLOOD EVEN IF HURRICANE WINDS AND RAIN CAUSED THE 6 FLOOD TO OCCUR. WITHOUT SEPARATE FLOOD INSURANCE COVERAGE, YOU MAY 7 HAVE UNCOVERED LOSSES CAUSED BY FLOOD. PLEASE DISCUSS THE NEED TO 8 PURCHASE SEPARATE FLOOD INSURANCE COVERAGE WITH YOUR INSURANCE 9 10 AGENT." SECTION 2. Section 2002.103, Insurance Code, as added by 11

11 SECTION 2. Section 2002.103, insurance code, as added by 12 this Act, applies only to an insurance policy delivered, issued for 13 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2020. A policy 14 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2020, 15 is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the 16 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for 17 that purpose.
