23	$\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ a commercial building or structure that is:
24	<u>(1)</u> [(A)] installed in a manner other than on a

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1 permanent foundation; and 2 (2) [(B)] either: 3 (A) [(i)] not open to the public; or 4 (B) [(ii)] less than 1,500 square feet in total 5 area and used other than as a school or a place of religious 6 worship. 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
