- 6 SECTION 1. Section 114.013, Human Resources Code, is
- 7 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (c) and
- 8 (d) to read as follows:
- 9 (b) As part of coordinating resources under Subsection (a),
- 10 the commission shall:
- 11 (1) collect and distribute information and research
- 12 regarding autism and other pervasive developmental disorders;
- 13 (2) conduct training and development activities for
- 14 persons who may interact with an individual with autism or another
- 15 pervasive developmental disorder in the course of their employment,
- 16 including school, medical, and [ex] law enforcement personnel, and
- 17 personnel of the Department of Family and Protective Services;
- 18 (3) coordinate with local entities that provide
- 19 services to an individual with autism or another pervasive
- 20 developmental disorder; and
- 21 (4) provide support for families affected by autism
- 22 and other pervasive developmental disorders.
- 23 (c) The commission shall ensure that training and
- 24 development activities under this section are:

- 1 (1) evidenced-based;
- 2 (2) applicable to the professional role of each type
- 3 of personnel to be trained under Subsection (b)(2); and
- 4 (3) instructive regarding means of effectively
- 5 communicating and engaging with individuals with limited social or
- 6 <u>verbal abilities.</u>
- 7 (d) At least once every five years, in consultation with an
- 8 institution of higher education, the commission shall revise the
- 9 materials and methods for the training and development activities
- 10 to be provided under Subsection (b)(2).
- 11 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2024, the executive
- 12 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 13 revise the materials and methods for the training and development
- 14 activities to be provided under Section 114.013(b)(2), Human
- 15 Resources Code, as amended by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
